Spiritual Principle: Hope In the Basic Text on page 23 of the Fifth Edition, it states, "Some of us didn't take this step seriously at first; we passed over it with a minimum of concern, only to find the next steps would not work until we worked Step Two." When I first came into the program, I surrendered to drugs. My Higher Power (as I understand Him now) saw fit to relieve me of the thing most dangerous to my existence. I can't pin point the exact time, but somewhere along the way after not picking up for some time, the desire to use was removed. I took the suggestions from others in the program and it worked. The program and the people in it were my Higher Power at that time. And from that small mustard seed of faith, my belief began to grow. Several years later into my recovery, I am now experiencing a deeper understanding of the Second Step; one that has caused me to strengthen my relationship with my own personal Higher Power. As I go through some of the toughest experiences in my recovery, some classified as "life on life's terms" and others labeled as self-induced, I am hit with a barrage of feelings and emotions. At this point in my recovery, I can't do what I would ordinarily do.....and that is use to my feelings. I can't pick up a drink or drug no matter what I'm feeling. I can't shop to my feelings because I'm attempting to practice responsibility. I can't sex to my feelings because I am attempting to practice faithfulness to my spouse. All of the things that I would normally use to fill the void have been removed and I am left with no other recourse but to feel the feelings. Sometimes emotions such as shame, guilt, and regret can be very painful and overwhelming. Even as I go through as I have so many times before, hope can seem distant. It is in these dark moments that I turn to my Higher Power for relief and support. In the beginning, the Program and the people in the Fellowship carried me through my trials and tribulations [as they still do]. I was like a kid learning to ride a bike and the Program and the Fellowship were the training wheels. But I am at a place now where only a personal relationship with a Higher Power can fill the void and replace my emptiness with peace, faith and hope. The pain of living without drugs or anything else to replace them has forced me to seek a Power greater than myself. The training wheels have been removed and I have to ride on faith. In the beginning of my process, my relationship with my Higher Power was minimal at best. I needed tangible evidence; to touch, feel and see. But now I understand the value of faith, hope and trust in a relationship with a Higher Power. As I go through these arduous times and experience feelings in the raw, I turn to my Higher Power for strength. The process of coming to believe is
